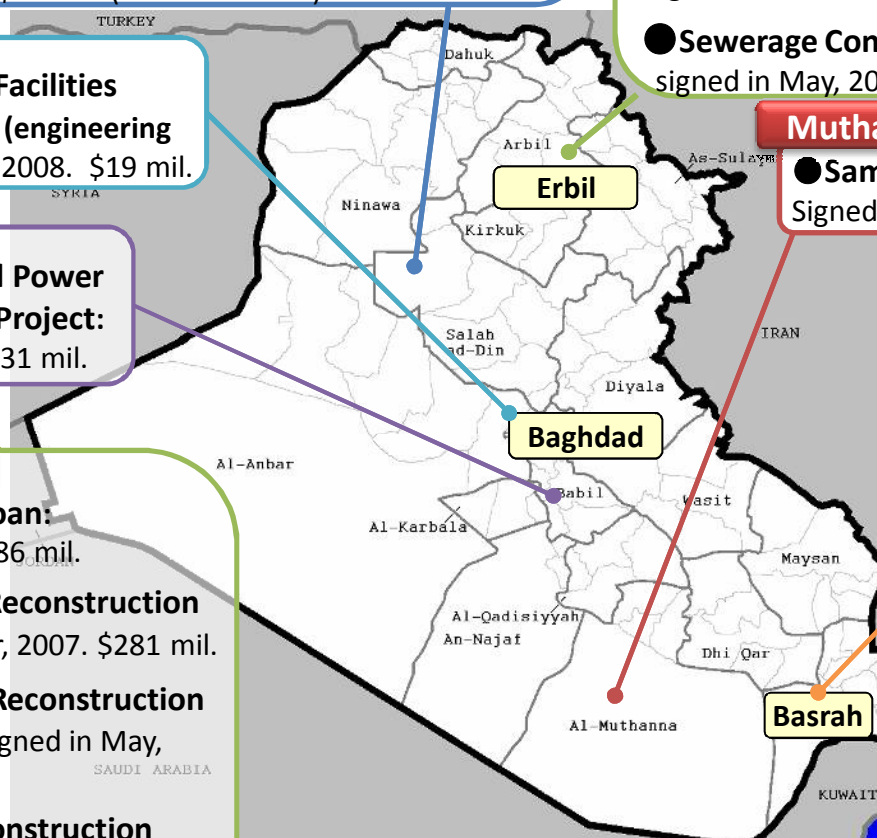

New assistance for IDPs and Syrian refugees in Feb, 2015 (Grant): \$ 90 million

- Humanitarian assistance (\$ 80.44 million) :
 - UNHCR (shelter)
 - UNDP (social cohesion, socio-economic infrastructure)
 - ICRC (sanitary items, drinking water)
 - IOM (transportation, non-food items)
 - OCHA (coordination among Iraqi Government, UN, NGOs and donors)
 - Japanese NGOs (JPF) (winterization measures, daily necessities, water, sanitation)
 - UN-HABITAT (pre-fabricated houses)
 - WFP (food)
 - UNOPS (ambulances)
 - IFRC (food, blankets)
- Assistance for Education (\$ 5.5 million) : UNESCO , UNICEF (rehabilitation of schools)
- Improvement of legal system and humanitarian situation (\$ 1.58 million) : UNODC, OHCHR
- Assistance for preservation of cultural sites (\$ 1.5 million) : UNESCO

Emergency Grant Assistance for IDPs in 2014: \$ 28.5 million

- In February, 2014 (\$ 1.8 million) : through UNHCR
- In June, 2014 (\$ 6 million) : through UNHCR, WFP, IOM, UNICEF, ICRC
- In September, 2014 (\$ 19.2 million) : through WFP, UNHCR, UNICEF, ICRC, IOM, OCHA
- In June, Sep., Nov. and Dec, 2014 (\$ 1.5 million) : through Japanese NGOs (PWJ, IVY, JEN)

Emergency Grant Assistance for Syrian refugees from 2012 to 2014: \$ 23.8million
